- **Showcase a performance** from your culture on a big stage. We are focusing on group performances and encouraging performances that can be inclusive to everyone who wishes to join. We encourage simple dances where the audience can join-in.
- **Families representing Mexico and India** will be working with Vanessa Aguiar and Anu Gopalam to coordinate their tables and performances.
